AN INTENSIVE RETURN TO WORK PROGRAM FOR PRINCIPAL CARER PARENTS

This innovative program aims to provide participants with the opportunity to work through the process of returning to work after an extended break from the paid workforce. The program will resource participants with information and strategies to address any fears or concerns about returning to work and addresses issues of self confidence faced by many parents returning to work. The program also provides participants with a mentor who will encourage, motivate and coach each participant towards positive social and employment outcomes.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

The program is funded by DEEWR through the Employment Innovation Fund so there are no costs associated with the program.

The cost of clothing, make-up and hairdressing are all covered by the DEEWR grant.

WHO IS THE PROGRAM AIMED AT?

The program is aimed at Job Seekers from Jobless families - specifically Principal Carer Parents. The project also targets disadvantaged parents, particularly those from areas of entrenched disadvantage, Indigenous Australians, the homeless and people with mental health issues.

HOW LONG IS THE PROGRAM?

The initial workshop program is completed within four weeks. This will be followed by Life Coaching sessions and general support and mentoring by our own staff. Where appropriate we may run further group sessions and in most cases we would like to continue meeting one-on-one with participants on an ongoing basis until sustainable employment is achieved..
